

## **NEWS ALERT: Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) and Changes to your Coverage**

Part B Insulin and Part B drug benefits on Florida Complete Care' Medicare Advantage plans are getting even better in 2023.

At Florida Complete Care', we strive to help our members achieve total health so that they may live their best lives, which includes efforts to provide our members with access to more affordable prescription drugs.

With the passing of the Inflation Reduction Act, all Medicare Advantage plans will have

enhanced benefits in 2023:

- Effective April 1, 2023, some rebatable Part B drugs may be subject to a lower coinsurance. This means beginning April 1, 2023, some Part B drugs will have a lower coinsurance than your standard part B drug coinsurance to help avoid increased cost for your Part B drugs.
- Effective July 1, 2023, cost sharing for covered Part B Insulin furnished through a covered item of durable medical equipment will be no more than \$35 for a one-month (up to 30-day) supply. Part B Insulin is most commonly used through an insulin pump.

You are not required to take any action on your part, but we recommend you keep this information for future reference.
